
God Made Everything

Genesis 1:1-24


God made everything that is good. He made the trees and flowers and animals and rivers.

Draw a picture of you and your family.




You are in God's family. God loves you.

They lived in a garden God made for them.


But they broke God's rules and were sent out of the garden.
