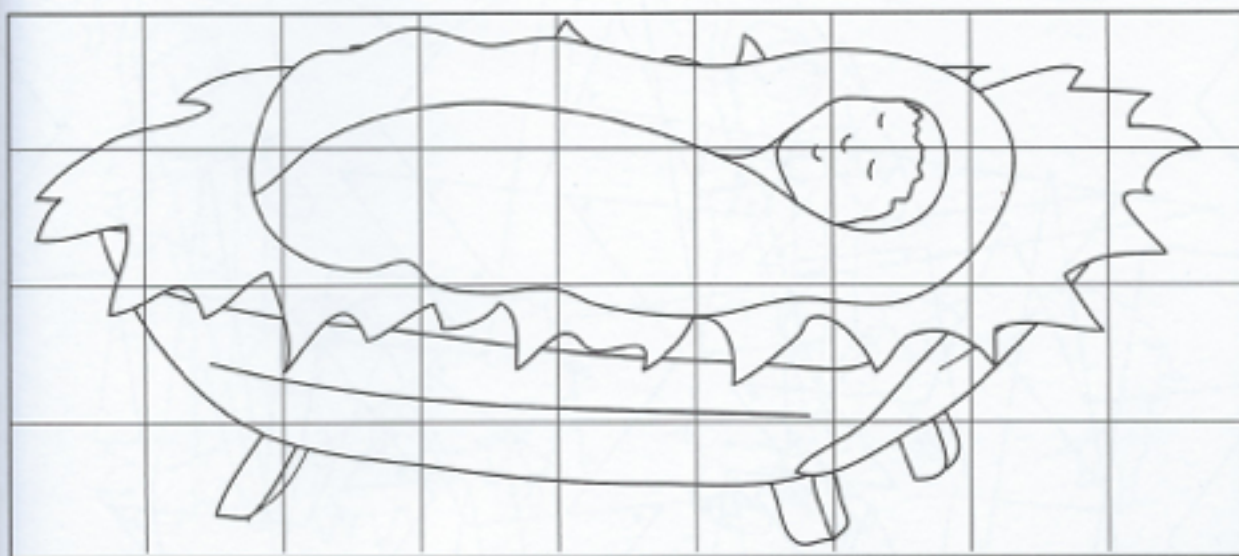
Jesus was born as a baby in Bethlehem. He grew up to be a perfect man, and the best teacher.
