

After the Flood Booklet B Teacher Notes

1. The Tower of Babel

The words in English are:

tower, tall, confused, language, people, God

If they can think of translations with similar meanings but not the exact meaning, that is fine too.

2. God's Promise to Abraham

They might like to talk about their own names and what they mean.

You could talk about promises, and why we can trust God to fulfil his promises.

3. God Tests Abraham

From the example of Abraham's story, discuss what God wants us to do:

- obey
- listen
- learn
- enjoy the good things that God has done for us..

You could talk about what good things God has done.

4. Jacob and Esau

If they do not understand about inheritance and birthright, have a discussion about what that means. Talk about the social and historical context.

You could also discuss what they have learned from bad choices they have made, but then make sure to talk about positives too.

When talking about forgiveness, remind them that when they say sorry for their sins, God will always forgive them.
